We were and still are the first-ever "all-volunteer community-based peer-to-peer recovery center", as we established and still maintain a no charge policy for our support services. We are a 501 c (3) corporation.

From our early days, the City of Angels family has been committed to helping those who suffer from the disease of alcohol and/or drug use. The losses associated with substance-use disorders are devastating and City of Angels has been there for these suffering families.

COA offers:

- A 24/7 hot line staffed by volunteers
- Volunteers trained as NIN interventionists
- Volunteers trained as CCAR Recovery Coaches
- Assistance with referrals to treatment centers and recovery programs
- Assistance navigating reentry into life after treatment
- Hosts support meetings such as AA, NA, Naranon and other self help groups
- Provides a safe and drug free meeting place
- COA alumni and volunteers visit schools with education and prevention presentations
